## Targeted training

Targeted training can be added to the programme as required by the course centre.

- anaphylaxis
- pregnancy
- care of the patient with tracheostomy or laryngectomy
- ReSPECT/ 'Do Not Attempt Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation' (DNACPR) orders
- audit
- equipment
- drugs
- further skills training and simulations.
